GLORIOUS DIVERSITY

Did you know that as recently as 1975, women were unable to open a bank account in their own name? A generation ago, same-sex couples could hardly hope they might be able to marry – something that is now entirely normal. It helps to remember that not all change is bad, and the world sometimes gets better rather than worse.

Saint Michael's has long been an inclusive church, challenging homophobia and misogyny in both Church and society. This year we celebrate 30 years since the ordination of women as priests. Recently we shared a statement looking forward to changes that enable us to hold special services for same-sex couples.

But the work of inclusion is never finished, and Lent is a time when we examine ourselves and ask hard questions about our hidden assumptions and attitudes. When St Paul wrote there is 'neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female', he was saying that Christ sets us free from our prejudices of race, class and gender (and in other ways too) - not to live in monochrome uniformity, but in glorious rainbow diversity, founded on our common humanity. It is hard to be honest with ourselves, but the outcome is joyful renewal that brings about an inner Easter for us all.


